

Membership Guidelines

1. Membership begins on July 1 and expires on June 30 of the following year. To ensure uninterrupted services and publications from FNAA, dues should be received by July 31st.

FNAA is a professional, education association of individuals and institutions, affiliated with the International Network of Performing and Visual Arts Schools (dba International Network of Schools for the Advancement of Arts Education). Membership dues, once paid for the year, are **non-refundable** and **non-transferable to another individual (transferable to another individual in Institutional Membership ONLY)**. It is acceptable for a school, institution or company to pay the annual dues for an individual member. However, the membership is for the named individual and is non-transferable (**transferable to another individual in Institutional Membership ONLY**) and non-refundable. **PURCHASE ORDERS ARE NOT ACCEPTED AS PAYMENT.** Payment must accompany this form.

2. Active and Institutional membership offers these additional benefits:
 - a. The right to vote and hold office in FNAA.
 - b. The right to attend national, divisional, state and local conventions, conferences and workshops upon fulfilling registration requirements; and,
 - c. Other member benefits offered through FNAA.
(Other classes of membership have the same privileges as active members except the right to vote and hold office)
4. Institutional Membership
Institutional Membership in FNAA shall be granted for up to three (3) individuals from the same educational institution (not to include associations, government agencies or business). Institutional memberships are transferable to other individuals, upon changes in staff, within the same institution upon proper notification to FNAA. Active institutional membership shall grant participation in the activities of FNAA including the right to vote upon business matters before the Association and to hold office.
5. Associate Membership
Associate Membership in FNAA will be granted to any individual, organization, institution or business firm, not actively engaged in the administration of arts programs, who are interested in the general advancement of arts education.
6. Retired Membership
Retired Membership in FNAA shall be available to Active members who retire under the provisions of Florida Law or their institution's retirement plan.

Note: Membership dues payments are not deductible as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes.
